

BULL SHOALS SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING

The Bull Shoals City Council met in special session on Friday, May 22, 2015 at 6:30 pm in the municipal building. On roll call, all Council Members were present as were the Mayor and Recorder/Treasurer.

Mayor:

Mayor Hotchkiss opened the meeting stating he called the meeting and our guest speaker is Arkansas Municipal League Attorney, Mike Mosley.

Topic:

City of Bull Shoals (2) current lawsuits

Mike Mosley speaks on the following (2) cases:

Knopick Case:

Mr. Mosley briefly discussed the Knopick lawsuit. He stated that he was not representing the City of Bull Shoals but Keith Wren is. Mr. Mosley is representing William Stahlman, Jr. He stated that he could not go into much with the Knopick case because he was not representing the City of Bull Shoals but did state that he was filing for dismissal on the grounds of the statute of limitations has expired to re-file this lawsuit. He would be filing this on Mr. Stahlman's behalf and he believed that Keith Wren would be doing the same on behalf of the City of Bull Shoals.


Dore Case:

Mr. Mosley briefly discussed the Dore lawsuit. He stated that he will be pushing for depositions in June. He will then file for a motion of summary judgment, which is a motion to dismiss – based on evidence.

Anna Harper asked about a letter received regarding being summoned to court in September or November this year. After brief discussion, it was noted that council should attend this settlement hearing on the date stated in the letter if the case has not already settled by then.


